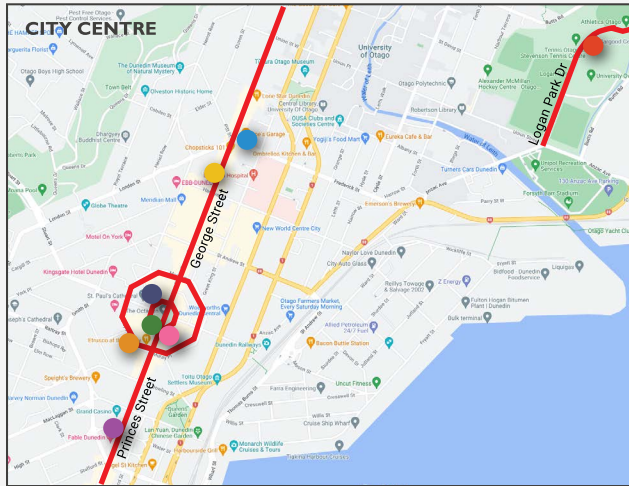
## SAFETY

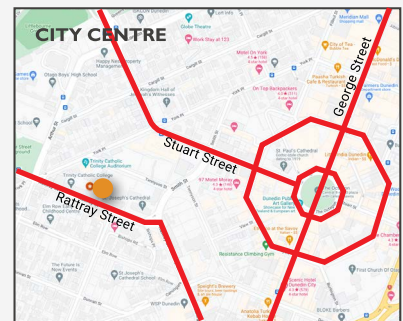
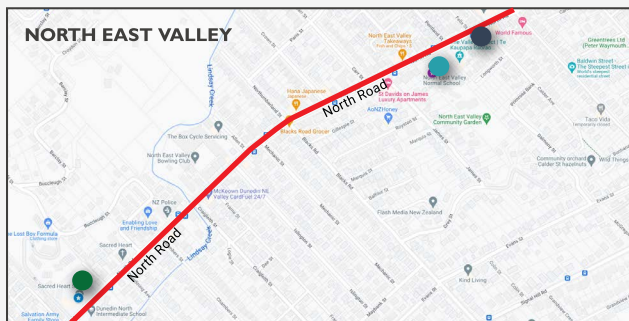
